

Day-O Infinity Scarf

Make a statement & embrace the fun & spookiness of Halloween with this Beetlejuice inspired Infinity scarf! Perfect to wear on those chilly October days & on Halloween night! Super easy to make, its pizazz is in the stripe detailing! It showcases different combinations of 3 colour stripe patterning. So versatile, it can be made in any colour combination to celebrate any season!!



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DAY-O INFINITY SCARF

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MATERIALS & INFO

METHOD: Knitting

NEEDLES: US 8/5 mm Circular Needle 17 inch

YARN: Yarn Weight 4 Worsted

PLEASE REFER TO THE GAUGE

Yarn A: White - approximately 285 yards
Yarn B: Black - approximately 560 yards

Yarn C: Lime - approximately 285 yards

GAUGE: 4" x 4" (10 cm x 10 cm): 18 sts x 24 rows

OTHER: Stitch Marker, Yarn Needle

SIZE: Adult One Size Fits All

FINAL MEASUREMENTS:

Infinity scarf measures : Width 7.5 inches (19 cm) , Length Folded in half 44 inches (112 cm)

SKILLS USED

Long Tail Cast On

Knitting in the Round

Knit Stitches

Colour Changes of yarn

Binding Off Loosely

Mattress Seaming

CONSTRUCTION

This infinity scarf is knit in 1 piece. It is knit in the round using a circular needle. By using a stitch marker to indicate the beginning of each row, you will easily know where to change yarn colour as per the pattern instructions. When you finish the striping pattern, you will have one long tube. It is important that you bind off loosely so that mattress seaming the two ends together will be easier. Once the cast on edge is seamed to the bound off edge, your scarf is finished! Feel free to lengthen or shorten as you like!



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ABBREVIATIONS

sts: stitches CO: cast on RS: right side K: knit BO - bind off knitwise Colour Pattern 1: Rows 1-2 YARN A Rows 3-4 YARN B Repeat the above 4 row pattern 21 times. -84 rows. Colour Pattern 2: Rows 1-2 YARN C Rows 3-4 YARN B Repeat the above 4 row pattern 21 times. - 84 rows. Colour Pattern 3: Rows 1-61 YARN B -61 rows. Colour Pattern 4: Rows 1-61 YARN C -61 rows. **Colour Pattern 5:** Rows 1-8 YARN A

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Repeat the above 16 row pattern 5 times. - 80 rows.

Rows 9-16 YARN B

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PATTERN

With YARN A, using the Long Tail Cast On, CO 64 sts. Place a stitch marker to indicate the beginning of the row.

While knitting in the round, work the following Colour Patterns (defined under Abbreviations) in the following order:

Work Colour Pattern 1 - 84 rows

Work Colour Pattern 2 - 84 rows.

Work Colour Pattern 3 - 61 rows.

Work Colour Pattern 1 - 84 rows.

Work Colour Pattern 4 - 61 rows.

Work Colour Pattern 2 - 84 rows.

Work Colour Pattern 5 - 80 rows.

When you have finished all of the above you will have a long tube - 538 rows.

Bind off loosely.

Finishing

Now you will want to join the cast on edge & the bound off edge together. You will do this using mattress stitching. Make sure to line up your long tube so that there are no twists in the tube when you join the two ends.

Weave in all ends & block to shape.
